

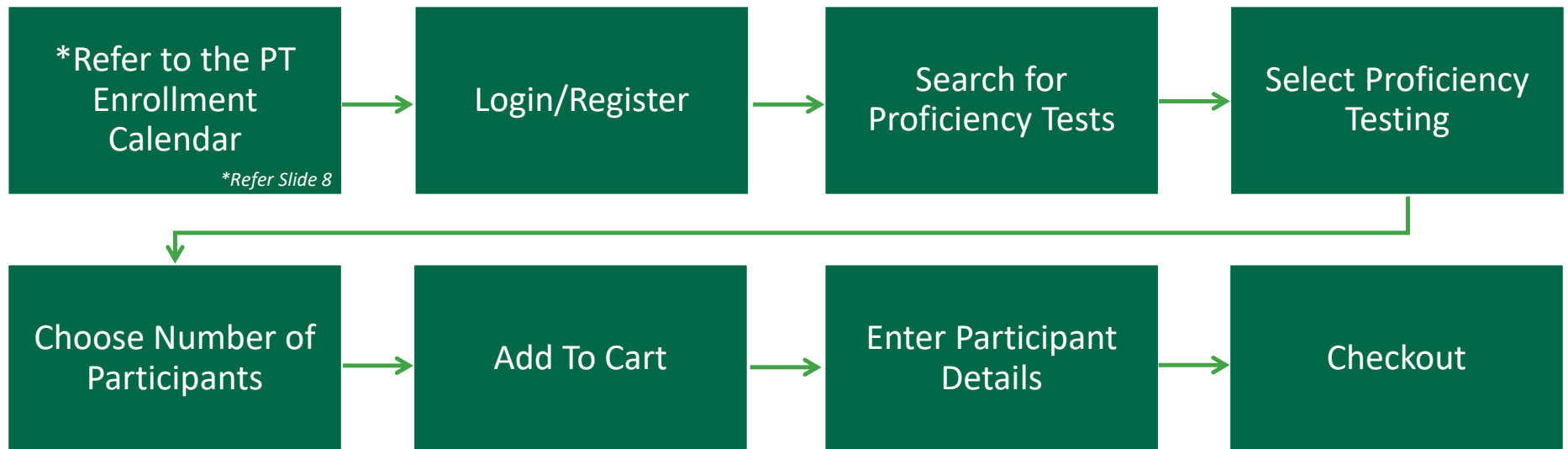

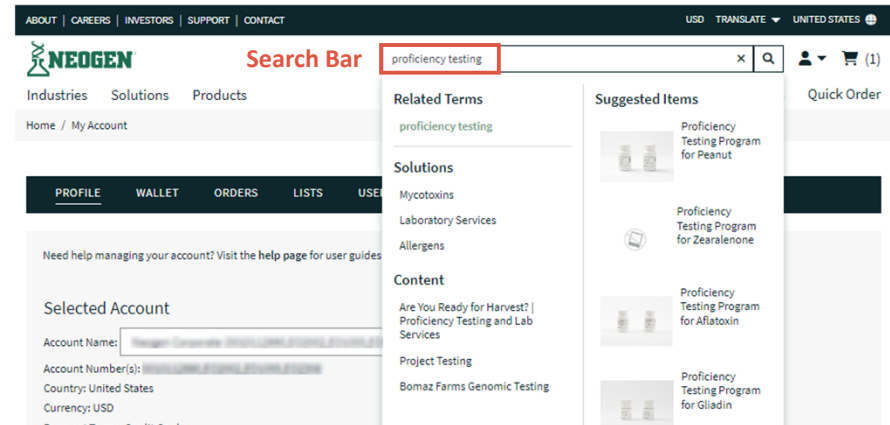
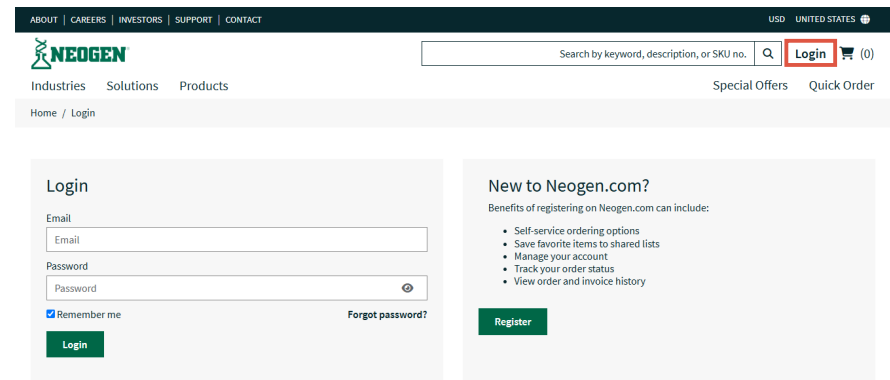
Follow these steps to easily order proficiency testing programs from Neogen.


